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D: SHARED METHODOLOGIES

D1 Cell Culture

D1.1 Biosafety containment cabinets (Class IIA or IIB) must be used for all cell cultures and for the handling of viable tissues and/or fluids.

D1.2 Incubators

- D1.2.1 Two incubators on separate electrical circuits (if no emergency backup power is available) are required for all amniotic fluid and chorionic villi cell cultures. These should have separate CO₂ sources and filters, and should have emergency temperature alarms.
- D1.2.2 Incubators must be cleaned regularly, and incubators must be monitored for 1) temperature each working day, 2) gas weekly, and 3) humidity, as needed. Maximum-minimum control thermometers are recommended. Appropriate operating ranges for equipment should be established and posted. Protocols should outline steps to be taken when readings are outside of appropriate ranges.
