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ACMG's Statement on Access to Reproductive Options after Prenatal Diagnosis

In 2013, ACMG published the "ACMG Statement on Access to Reproductive Options after Prenatal Diagnosis." In light of recent legislative activity in certain states prohibiting termination of pregnancy based on the results of a prenatal diagnosis, ACMG would like to remind members of this statement and invite them to refer to it. It states in part, "The American College of Medical Genetics and Genomics is concerned with the enactment of laws in some states that prevent or restrict access to termination of pregnancy after prenatal diagnosis of genetic disorders or congenital anomalies."
