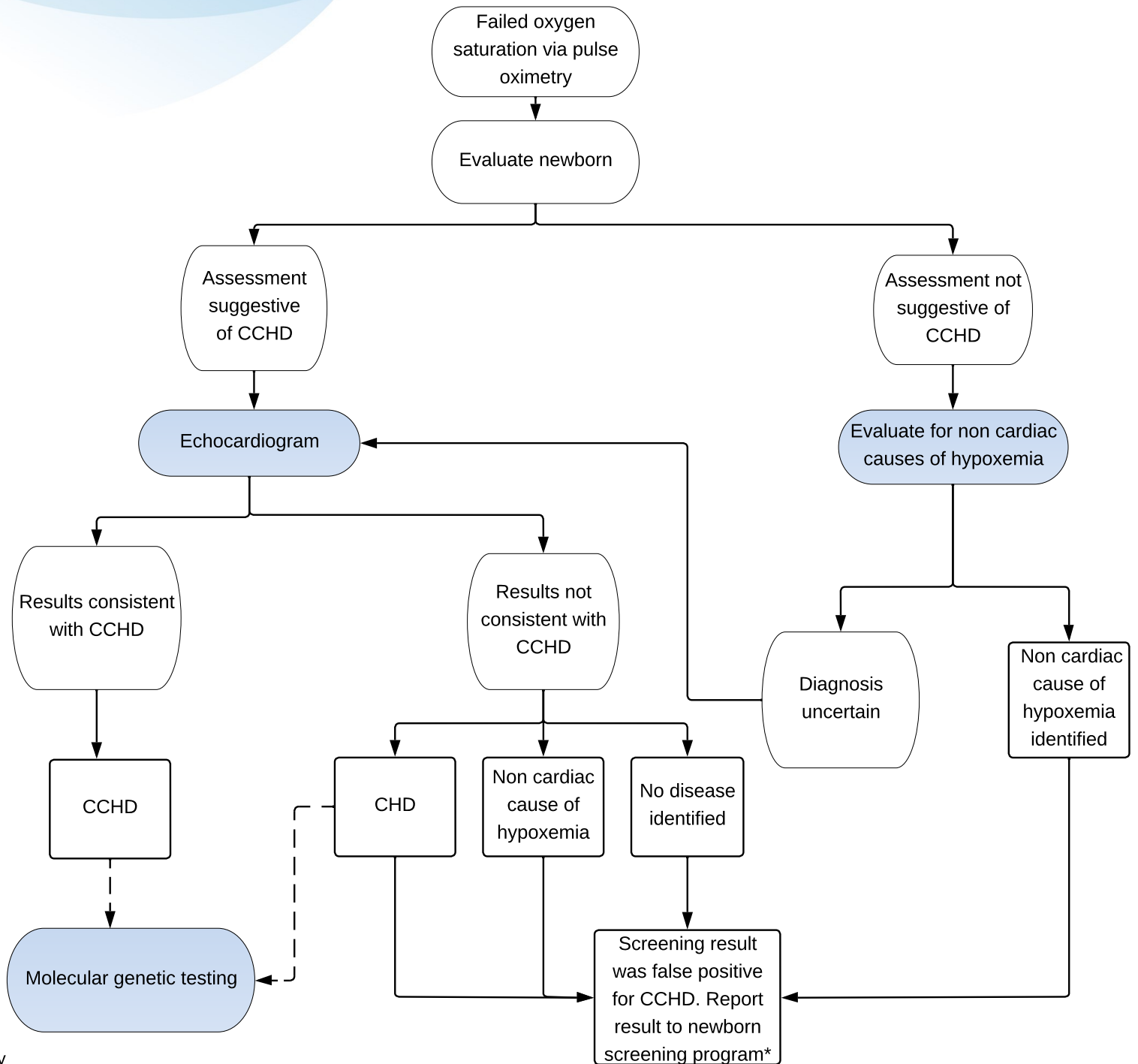


CCHD: Abnormal oxygen saturation
